

FAQ: The MB-Ruler loupe does not show the area of the current cursor position

This can happen, if the screen scale is not set to 100% for better readability.

Make it easier to read what's on your screen

You can change the size of text and other items on your screen by choosing one of these options. To temporarily enlarge just part of the screen, use the [Magnifier](#) tool.



☐ Smaller - 100% (default) Preview 

☐ Medium - 125%

☒ Larger - 150%



Normally MB-Ruler calculates the values for correct display automatically.
In rare reasons, it fails.

This way you will solve this issue:

Follow this step by step instruction for each of the REG files, until the content of the screen loupe is correct.

1. Close MB-Ruler, if active
2. Double click ScaledScreenScreenShotMethod<0-3>.reg
A value will be written to the registry. Depending on your system, administrator rights are necessary.
3. Start MB-Ruler
4. Check the loupe function
5. Continue with the next REG file, if the content of the loupe is not correct
